Ron Foxcroft Inducted Into Hamilton Sports Hall of Fame



Sports Officials Canada would like to congratulate our good friend Ron Foxcroft on his induction into the Hamilton Sports Hall of Fame. He will be only the second referee to be inducted into the Hamilton Sports Hall of Fame. Foxcroft was amongst the group of individuals chosen including local legends Pat Quinn, Dave Andreychuk, Cecelia Carter Smith and Garney Henley. They join some of last year's inaugural inductees which include retired NHL referee Bill Friday, David Braley and the 1967 Hamilton Tiger Cats.

Foxcroft, who is known for being a major local community sports activist, joins the exclusive group for good reason. He was NCAA's first Canadian Basketball referee, and has refereed in more than 30 countries over 35 years. He is the inventor of the Fox 40 Pealess Whistle and was recently named one of 52 most influential referees in North American History by Referee Magazine.

The induction ceremonies will take place in Hamilton on September 27th.
