

2010/11 EXAM

In the framework of the National Official Certification Program (NOCP), the passing mark for Level 1 is 35/50 (70%), 40/50 (80%) for Level 2, and 43/50 (86%) for Levels 3 and 4. This exam is to be written by all ABOA members. The passing mark for national assignments shall be 43/50 (86%). The passing mark for ACAC and ASAA assignments shall be 40/50 (80%). The general passing mark is 33/50 (66%). The questions are based on the current FIBA rulebook. All active ABOA members will write the exam in a closed book setting. The exam consists of 50 "YES-NO" questions. Using a pencil, shade in A for YES or B for NO on the accompanying answer sheet. There is no time limit for this exam.

1. Y N On the jump ball at the beginning of the first quarter, does the interval of play end when the ball is legally tapped by a jumper?
2. Y N A violation is committed for illegally returning the ball to the backcourt. Shall the resulting throw-in be administered at the centre line extended, opposite the scorer's table?
3. Y N A final free-throw by A2 does not touch the ring or enter the basket. Shall play resume with a Team B throw-in at the free-throw line extended?
4. Y N While the ball is in the air on a successful last free throw by A2, A4 and B4 commit a double foul. Shall play resume with an alternating possession throw-in?
5. Y N With 1:52 remaining in the 2nd quarter, B6 reports to the scorer as a substitute. Team A then scores a field goal. Shall B6 now be permitted to enter the game?
6. Y N A1 who is straddling the mid-court line catches a pass from A2 from the Team A backcourt. Shall the official stop the 8-second count?
7. Y N The ball is in the team B basket as a result of a field goal attempt by A3 when A4 contacts the basket. Is this an interference violation by A4?
8. Y N With 1:39 remaining in the extra quarter, Team B commits a traveling violation in their frontcourt. Team A is awarded a throw-in in their backcourt and then is granted a time-out. Shall the resulting throw-in be taken at the mid-court line extended, opposite the scorer's table?
9. Y N B3 commits an unsportsmanlike foul against A3 who is injured and is replaced by substitute A6. May any Team A player who was on the playing court at the time of the A3 injury attempt the resulting free-throws?
10. Y N A2 has control of the ball in Team A's frontcourt, when B4 taps the ball out of A2's hands and the ball rolls into Team A's backcourt. Shall the 8-second count start as soon as any Team A player touches the ball?
11. Y N Team A is awarded a throw-in with 0:00.2 displayed on the game clock. Thrower-in A2 passes the ball to airborne player A4, who directly dunks the ball into the basket. Are the officials correct in counting the basket?
12. Y N A2 is dribbling the ball from his backcourt and ends his dribble holding the ball and straddling the centre line. A2 then passes the ball to A1 who is also straddling the centre line. Is this action legal?
13. Y N In Team A's frontcourt, A1 passes to A2, but B1 deflects the ball out of bounds. The shot clock shows 9 seconds. On Team A's throw-in, shall the shot clock be reset to 14?
14. Y N Team A executes a throw-in from the end line of their backcourt. With the ball still in Team A's backcourt, the official notices that the 24 second clock has not started. The official blows his whistle and resumes play at the nearest point out of bounds with a new 24 second clock and a new 8 second count for Team A. Is the official correct?
15. Y N A1 is setting a screen against defender B1. Must A1 face B1 for the screen to be legal?
16. Y N A3 is holding the ball and is closely guarded by B3. Must B3 allow enough space to A3 for him to pivot?
17. Y N Team A is granted a time-out. After 25 seconds into the time-out, Team A is ready to play. Shall play resume immediately?
18. Y N While A1 is in the act of shooting, A2 and B2 commit a double foul. A1, after the whistle sounds, in a continuous motion A1 releases the try for goal and the ball enters the basket. Shall the basket count?
19. Y N A3 is awarded 2 free throws plus possession because of an unsportsmanlike foul by B5. The official hands A3 the ball for the first free throw and before A3 can release the ball, the official calls a technical foul on A4. The official rules that the two penalties cancel each other. Is the official correct?
20. Y N With 1:23 to play in the fourth quarter, the ball is in the hands of an official who is just about to put the ball at the disposal of A3 for a throw-in. B5 causes contact with A2. The official calls a foul on B5. By rule must this be an unsportsmanlike foul?
21. Y N B5 fouls A5 during an unsuccessful try for goal. It is then discovered that A5 is participating as a sixth player for Team A. A5 must leave the game. The official rules that the free throws resulting from the B5 foul shall be attempted by any Team A player on the playing court at the time of the foul, as designated by Coach A. Is the official correct?
