

## Quiz #2: Rule 4: Sections 11 thru 20

**(CIRCLE THE CORRECT "YES" OR "NO" ANSWER)**

**Q1: (Rule 4 – Sections 12)**

A1 is dribbling the ball in Team A's back court when the ball accidentally strikes his/her foot and bounces away. During the interrupted dribble A1 fouls B1 in an attempt to recover the ball and continue the dribble. The official calls a player control foul. Is the official correct?

**Q2: (Rule 4 – Section 15)**

While A-1 is dribbling in Team A's backcourt, the ball legally touches B-1's leg, causing it to bounce away from A-1. A-1 quickly recovers the ball with two hands and then starts another dribble. The official rules a double dribble violation. Is the official correct?

**Q3: (Rule 4 – Section 12)**

A-1's missed try rebounds directly to A's backcourt where A-2 gains control. The official rules a back court violation. Is the official correct?

**Q4: (Rule 4 – Section 15)**

A-1's throw in pass is muffed by A-2 hitting both A-2s hands and falling to the ground. A-2 recovers the muffed pass and begins a dribble. The official rules a double dribble violation. Is the official correct?

**Q5: (Rule 4 – Section 19)**

A-1 is passing the ball to A-2 in the front-court when B-2 deflects the pass. As A-2 and B-2 are attempting to retrieve the loose ball, A-2 illegally pushes B-2 from behind and is called for a foul. Team B is in the bonus. The official awards a throw-in to Team B at the point nearest where the foul occurred. Is the official correct?

**Q6: (Rule 4 – Section 15)**

A-1, while attempting to rebound, touches the ball with two hands which then bounces on the ground before A-1 recovers it. A-1 then pushes the ball to the ground to begin a dribble. The official rules a double dribble. Is the official correct?

**Q7: (Rule 4 – Section 15)**

A-1 is standing still in the frontcourt, holding the ball in both hands. A-1 touches the ground with the ball, then touches the ball to the ground again. Official rules a double-dribble. Is the official correct?

A-1 in his/her backcourt throws the ball against the opponent's back board. A-1 then catches the ball and begins a dribble. The official rules a double dribble. Is the official correct?

**Q9: (Rule 4 – Section 14)**

A-1 is fouled by B-2 and is awarded two free throws. The foul is B-2's fifth personal foul. The calling official, after reporting the foul at the table, is advised by the Scorer that B-2 has five fouls. The non-calling official then notifies Team B's Coach of the disqualification, notifies B-2 then asks the timer to start the 20 second substitution interval, with a horn at 15 seconds. The non-calling official allows Team B Coach the twenty second substitution interval. After the substitute has properly reported and is beckoned into the game the two free throws are attempted. Did the officials follow the proper disqualification procedure?
