Q1: (Rule 4 – Sections 23)

B-1 jumps in front of dribbler A-1 and obtains a legal guarding position with both feet touching the court and facing A-1. Dribbler A-1 contacts B-1's torso. The official rules a player control foul on A-1. Is the official correct?

Q2: (Rule 4 – Section 29)

A-1 has the ball for a throw-in. A-1 rolls the ball to A-2 who stops the ball by putting his/her foot on top of it, then bends over and picks up the ball. The official rules an intentional kick violation. Is the official correct?

Q3: (Rule 4 – Section 35)

A-1's has both feet on the floor behind the three-point line. A-1 jumps and released the ball on a successful try and then lands inside the line. The official awards a two point basket. Is the official correct?

A-1 three-point try is short and below the ring level when it hits the shoulder of B-1 and rebounds to the backboard and through the basket. Due to the confusion which follows the official stops play. The official awards two points to Team A and allows Team B to inbound the ball anywhere along the end-line. Is the official correct?
