Why do we need to know:

Player Control?

- 🏀 player control foul
- 🏀 calling timeouts
- 🏀 closely guarded
- 🏀 dribble & travel
- 🏀 other?

Team Control?

- 🏀 3 seconds
- 🏀 10 seconds
- 🏀 backcourt violation
- 🏀 team control fouls
- 🏀 other?

Player Control

(4-12-1)

There is **player control** when a player is:

- holding or dribbling
- a live ball
- inbounds

Player Control

(4-12-1)

There is **no player control**:

- During an interrupted dribble
- When a jumper catches the ball
- When the ball is at the disposal of the thrower-in

Team Control

(4-12-2)

A team **is** in control:

- when a player is in control,
or
- when a live ball is being passed among
teammates,
or
- during an interrupted dribble,
or
- when at the disposal of the thrower-in

Team Control

(4-12-3)
continued

Team control continues until:

- the ball is in flight on a tap or a try,
or
- an opponent secures control,
or
- the ball becomes dead

Control Fundamentals

(4-12-4)

1. A loose ball (other than a tap or try) which is live is in control of the team last having player control.

2. No team control during the touching of a rebound, until a player secures control

Control Fundamentals

(4-12-6)
continued

3. No team or player control during:

- a **dead ball**, nor
- a **jump ball**, nor
- when ball in flight during a **tap** or **try**
