FIBA RULES EXAM
2006-2007

The passing mark for national recognition shall be 43/50 (86%). The provincial association is responsible to determine the conditions under which this exam shall be completed. To be eligible to referee at a national tournament played under the FIBA rules, officials must write this exam in a closed-book supervised environment. The exam consists of 50 «YES-NO» questions. Signify your choice by crossing out (x) the appropriate answer. There is no time limit for this exam.

1. Y N In the last 2 minutes of the 4th quarter, A1 is dribbling in the backcourt when B2 deflects the ball out of bounds. Team A requests a timeout. The official instructs the 24-second operator to reset the shot clock. Is the official correct?
2. Y N B1 jumps from his/her front court, intercepts a pass thrown by A1, and lands in his/her backcourt. Is this a backcourt violation?
3. Y N No Team B player is occupying the first rebound space during A1's last free throw. A1 misses the free throw. Shall a replacement free throw be awarded to A1?
4. Y N The ball is on the ring on a try for goal by A1. B1 jumps and bats the ball away. Is this a violation by B1?
5. Y N With 18 seconds left on the 24-second clock, B1 intentionally kicks a pass intended for A2. The official instructs the operator to leave the shot clock at 18 seconds. Is the official correct?
6. Y N During the interval between the 1st and 2nd quarters, B6 disrespectfully addresses an official. Shall a technical foul be assessed to the Team B coach?
7. Y N B5 commits a disqualifying foul that does not involve contact with an opponent. Shall any Team A player attempt the resulting free throws?
Y N While holding the ball, A3 is being closely guarded by B2 who has both feet on the floor and is facing A3. B2 does not allow sufficient room for A3 to pivot without contact. Is B2 in a legal guarding position?
9. Y N A1 is awarded one free throw. After the ball is placed at the disposal of A1, Team A requests a time out. A1's free throw is successful. Shall Team A be granted the time out at this time?
10. Y N A5 is awarded 2 free throws. While the ball is dead following the first free throw, A1 is assessed a technical foul. Substitute A10 now requests to enter the game to replace A1. Shall A10 be permitted to enter the game immediately?
11. Y N The assistant coach of Team B addresses the scorer and requests a time-out. At the next opportunity, shall the time-out be granted?
12. Y N A4 has been dribbling the ball for 3 seconds in A's backcourt when a double foul is called. On the ensuing throw-in by A1, A2 catches the ball in Team A's back court. Does Team A have 5 seconds to cause the ball to move into A's frontcourt?
13. Y N On a try for goal by A2, the ball is within the basket when the ball is touched by A5. The ball passes through the basket. Shall the basket by A2 be disallowed?
14. Y N While A1 is dribbling the ball in the backcourt, A5 remains in Team B's restricted area for more than 3 seconds. Shall a violation be called on A5?
15. Y N During the initial jump ball between A1 and B1, the ball is legally tapped and is simultaneously controlled by A5 and B5, creating a held ball situation. Shall the official hold a new jump ball involving the same initial jumpers, A1 and B1?
16. Y N With 1:35 to play in the 4th period, in attempting a lay up, B1 charges into A1 before releasing the ball. B1 then releases the ball and the ball enters the basket. The official calls a team control foul on B1 and disallows the basket. Team A is granted a time-out. When play resumes, shall the throw-in take place at the free throw line extended?
17. Y N As the horn sounds to end the first period, B1 commits an unsportsmanlike foul on A1. The possession arrow favours Team B. Shall the second period begins with a Team B throw-in according to the alternating process?
18. Y N A5 is successful on his last free throw. After the ball is at the disposal of B1 for the throw-in, Coach B requests a time-out. Shall the time-out be granted at this time?
Y N By rule, should the home team (Team A) coach be the first to confirm his list of players and the five players identified to start the game?
20. Y N A1 releases the ball on a try for goal. The 24-second signal sounds and then B1 touches the ball while it is still in its upward flight. The ball then enters the basket. The official disallows the basket and announces a 24-second violation. Is the official correct?
21. Y N A1 releases a try for goal. The official blows his whistle for a foul by B4. The ball hits the rim and is rolling on it when B1 bats the ball away. Is this a violation?
