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Correctable Errors

1. Types:

Only 5 and 4 involve **free throws**:

- Not awarding a **merited** free throw
- Awarding an **unmerited** free throw
- Allowing **wrong player** to shoot free throw
- Shooting free throw at **wrong basket**

Correctable Errors

1. Types:

The last:

- Erroneously counting or not counting a score

Correctable Errors






2. Statute of Limitations

Must be recognized by an official:

- During first dead ball
- After the clock has properly started
- Following the error

Correctable Errors

2. Statute of Limitations

Error				
Dead Ball 	Live Ball 	Running or starts 	Dead Ball (clock stops?) 	Live Ball 
Correctable				No longer correctable

Correctable Errors

3. How to correct:

- a) Not awarding a **merited** free throw (bonus?)
 - 1. Award free throw and resume play:
 - No change of possession – from free throw action
 - Change of possession – from point of interruption

Correctable Errors

3. How to correct :

- b) Awarding an **unmerited** free throw
 - 1. Cancel all free throw activity
(points, fouls-except unsporting, flagrant, intentional, Ts)
 - 2. Resume play at point of interruption

Correctable Errors

3. How to correct :

- c) Allowing **wrong player** to shoot free throw
- d) Shooting free throw at **wrong basket**
 1. Cancel all free throw activity
(points, fouls-except unsporting, flagrant, intentional, Ts)
 2. Administer free throw with no line up
 3. Resume play at point of interruption

Correctable Errors

3. How to correct :

- e) Erroneously counting or not counting a score
 - 1. Award or cancel points
 - 2. Resume play at the point of interruption

Correctable Errors

4. Notes:

Points scored, time consumed etc.

- Between error and recognition of error
- Not nullified
